ANNOUNCEMENTS

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY: Catholics believe in one single God, who made himself known to the world (revelation) as three separate persons: God the Father, God the Son (Jesus) and God the Holy Spirit. This is known as the doctrine of the Trinity, and is a fundamental belief for all Catholics. The Trinity is a mystery which means that Catholics can never fully understand this idea. The Incarnation is the Christian belief that God becomes flesh (human) in the person of Jesus. "There are three things in love...love is of someone that loves, and with love something is loved. Behold, then, there are three things: he that loves, and that which is loved, and love." (*St Augustine*). "We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty...We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God...We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life." (*Nicene Creed*). "The word became flesh and made his dwelling among us" (*John*)

PETER'S PENCE: By reason of the bond of unity and charity, the bishops of the Church, with their people, join together to produce those means which the Holy Father and the Apostolic See need to exercise works of mercy and charity and its service of the Universal Church. The faithful's offerings to the Holy Father are destined to church needs, humanitarian initiatives and social promotion projects, as well as to the support of the Holy See. The Pope, being pastor of the whole Church, is attentive to the material needs of poor dioceses, religious institutes and faithful in grave difficulties: the poor, children, the elderly, those marginalised and the victims of war and natural disasters. Concrete aid is thus made available to bishops or dioceses in need, to Catholic education, assistance, to refugees and immigrants, etc...
