DEVOTION TO THE HOLY ROSARY: The month of October is a month dedicated to the devotion to the **Holy Rosary** (October 7). In October 2002 our Holy Father John Paul II wrote the Apostolic Letter *Rosarium Virginis Mariae* (the Rosary of the Virgin Mary)." This letter introduced five new mysteries, called the Luminous or Mysteries of Light, which are (1) Jesus' Baptism in the Jordan, (2) Jesus' self-manifestation at the wedding of Cana, (3) Proclamation of the Kingdom of God, with the call to conversion, (4) the Transfiguration, and (5) the Institution of the Eucharist.

Let us all try to make a more concerted effort to pray the Rosary together as a family during the month of October. October 16 is known as "Pope Day" on which we celebrate the gift of the papacy and our current pope.
