CREATION: "Monday 1st September: The World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation: For this year's World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, the theme is 'Seeds of Peace and Hope'. Pope Leo writes, 'Seeds are buried in the earth, and there, to our wonder, life springs up, even in the most unexpected places, pointing to the promise of new beginnings.' 1st September, the official start of the Season of Creation, is a time of sustained prayer and action which lasts a month and four days. 'As yet,' the Holy Father continues, 'we seem incapable of recognizing that the destruction of nature does not affect everyone in the same way. When justice and peace are trampled underfoot, those who are most hurt are the poor, the marginalised and the excluded.'
